The reporting person has elected to defer the receipt of common stock upon the vesting of the RSUs, and upon vesting of the RSUs, will receive deferred stock units ("DSUs") under the Amended and Restated Louisiana-Pacific Corporation Non-Employee Directors Compensation Plan. Each DSU entitles the reporting person to receive one share of common stock upon the earliest of (i) the reporting person's separation of service as a director or (ii) a change of control of the issuer.

2. Includes 33 shares credited as dividend equivalents on RSUs. Total reflects 5,793 DSUs held by the reporting person (including DSUs credited as dividend equivalents).
